<u>Code of Conduct (CoC): adopted as a mandatory commitment for Team-NB</u> <u>members</u>

On the October 9th, 2012, the Team-NB members met in a general assembly. They adopted the CoC version 3 by a large majority (79%). The members agreed to consider the requirements of CoC to become mandatory for all Team-NB members.

The document's purpose is to improve the implementation of the European CE marking certification of medical devices through clarified organizational criteria, management of competences and assessment practices.

The version 3 of this document contains the following topics :

- 1. Implementation, enforcement and monitoring of the Code of Conduct
- 2. Qualification and Assignment of Notified Body Assessment Personnel
- 3. Minimum time for Notified Body assessments
- 4. Unannounced visits
- 5. Sampling of class IIa and IIb technical files
- 6. Design Dossier Reviews
- 7. Rules for subcontracting
- 8. Rules for Certification Decisions

Further revisions will be made to be in line with the new developpments of the European legislation.
